**Background**

Qatar Vinyl Company (QVC) was Qatar’s first downstream petrochemical project. It has been designed to produce 290,000 M/T/y of caustic soda, 175,000 of ethylene dichloride and 230,000 of vinyl chloride monomer.

**Requirement**

QVC required a new incinerator unit to be designed, installed and commissioned. The successful implementation of the unit would increase production by over one third.

**Our Response**

HFL provided all civil, structural, piping, E&I and project management services.
